Brea Canyon Road Grade Separation

This project is part of the Gateway to America Trade Corridor and began construction in July 2006. This state of the art grade separation for the Alameda Corridor East Construction Authority encompassed third party utility relocations, construction of seven concrete retaining walls, several drainage systems totaling 1.5 miles, 26 precast-pre-stressed concrete girders for a new Union Pacific Rail Road bridge, 5,500 tons of asphalt and 4,500 cubic yards of concrete roadways and 55,000 square foot of new parking lot improvements.

Through Partnering, Griffith Company and the Owner worked diligently to deal with utility issues and to resolve all project concerns. Griffith's team provided an acceleration schedule to reduce the project delay by 150 days. Opened in October 2008, vehicular and rail traffic independently flow without stopping, bringing an esthetically pleasing addition to the community. For our efforts, Griffith Company was chosen as a finalist for the 2009 AGC California Excellence in Partnering Award.
